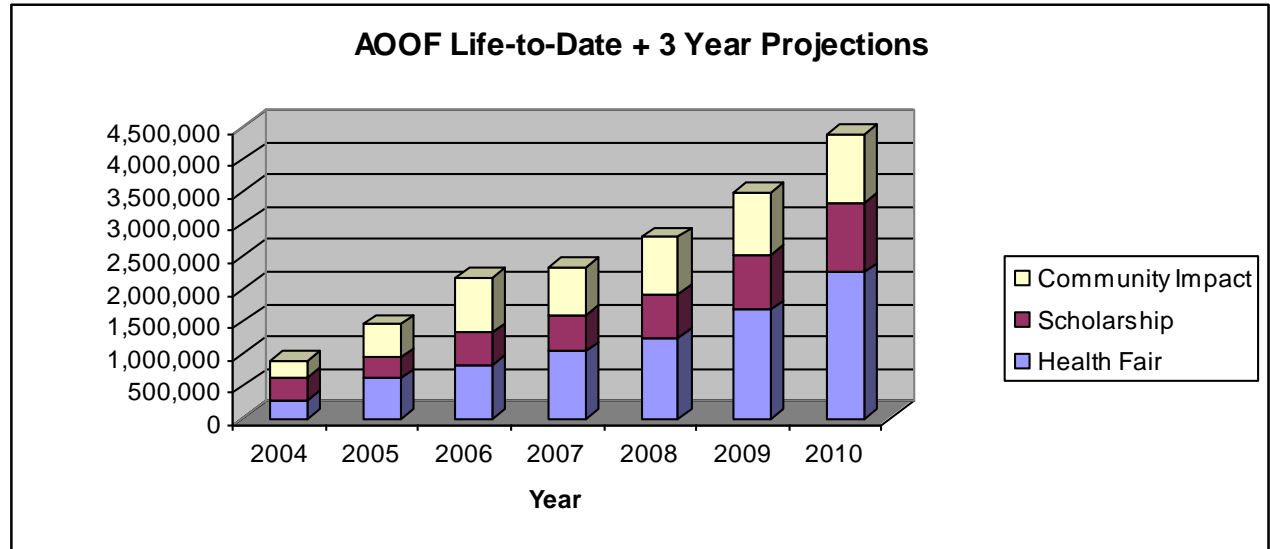

These annual projections would see the Foundation Outreach programs grow by nearly 100% over the next 3 years.



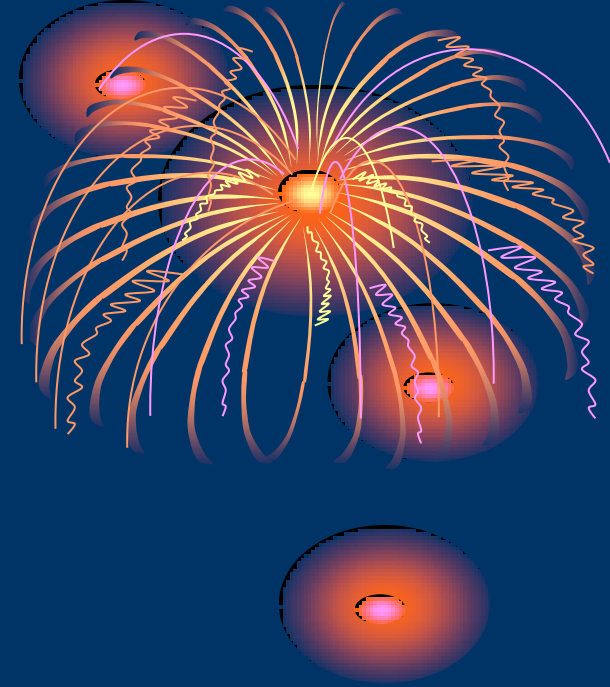

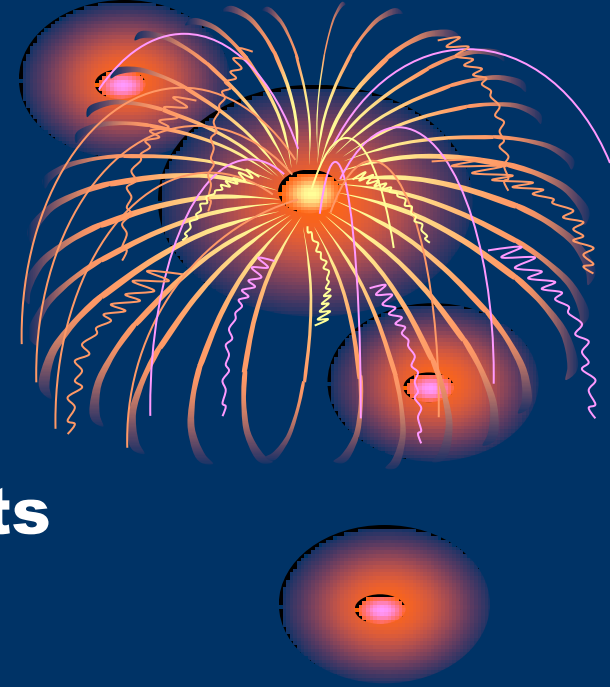

# Onikooko Primary School: Situation

- Location:
  - The primary school is located in Onikooko village which is a rural AFIJIO community.
- Student Population:
  - There are approximately 400 students at the school from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Condition:
  - Deplorable and dilapidated classroom blocks, most with collapsed walls and roofs.
  - At least 50% of the students receive instructions outside in the open, and under trees.
  - No safe drinking water, and no sanitary toilet facilities.

## Project Objectives

- To lift up the children of the Onikooko village by providing a reasonable and sanitary learning environment which includes:
  - a new water well; and
  - a new building block with two classroom units.



# Onikooko Primary School

## Objective: New Water Well

- This objective was initiated in partnership with Wells4Africa and the IITA Students.
- It was successfully completed and commissioned in March 2008!



# Onikooko Primary School

## Objective: New Building Block

• Foundation & Flooring:	\$1800	
• Wall Framing:	\$4,500	
• Roofing:	\$2,600	
• Doors & Windows:	\$1,500	
• Electrical:	\$500	
• Painting:	\$500	
• Keys & Locks:	\$100	
– Total Costs:		\$11,500
• Contingency (20%):	\$2,300	
• <b>Grand Total:</b>		<b>\$13,800</b>

# AOOF - Education

## Onikooko Primary School

- Project Commencement – May 29, 2008



- Building funded exclusively through the generous contributions of AOOF supporters.



# AOOF - Education

## Onikooko Primary School

- August 6, 2008: New classroom building near completion.



- Although not a massive structure, this classroom block was erected in the village at incredible speed.





# AOOF - Education

## Onikooko Primary School

- Next Steps:
  - Official Commissioning slated for August 29, 2008.
  - This building block contains two classrooms that will accommodate 80 students.
  - AOOF will raise funds to furnish classrooms with durable chairs and tables.



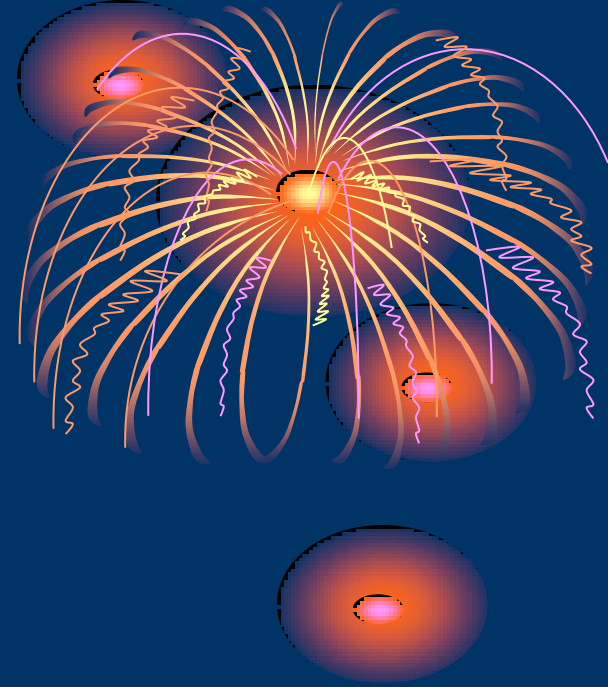
